

ITEST Fellows

A primary goal of the STELAR Center is to build the capacity of future PIs and help diversify the ITEST portfolio and PI community. With this in mind, PIs of ITEST projects were given an opportunity to nominate a non-PI "fellow" (such as an educator, postdoc, graduate student, or a leader at an institution that serves diverse learners) who could jointly attend the Summit and enrich our deliberations.
